**Old Business:**

1. MKRC’s FY26 MoDOT Work Plan Approval
  - o Quorum was not met in person. The plan moved for a virtual vote and obtained the required votes before presenting it to the Executive Board and ultimately sending the final version to MoDOT on June 30<sup>th</sup>.

1. Upcoming Lettings and Recent Awards
  - a. September
    - i. I-29 Resurfacing (Pigeon Creek to Platte County).
    - ii. US 36 at Bob Giffin Road (Cameron) - various improvements
  - b. October
    - i. Signing Project on I-29, I-229, and US 36
  - c. STIP Update
    - i. 2025: \$35 million transferred forward to fund I-35 rehabilitation projects.
    - ii. 2027: Adjustments in programming tied to statewide priorities.
    - iii. 2028: \$104 million programmed for major bridge projects, including I-229.
    - iv. 10 projects within the Mo-Kan and St. Joseph MPO area
  - d. LPA Updates

- i. Applications received: Bethany (\$231,145.76), Carrollton (\$182,264.00), Savannah (\$115,200.00), St. Joseph (\$252,000.00), Trenton (\$308,811.50).
    - ii. Total Requested: \$1,089,421.26 | Available: \$1,553,717.00.
    - iii. Funding Plan : All projects under review; anticipated awards for all.
  - e. Committee Feedback

- 2. FY26 TAP Grant
  - a. Calls for projects opened in May and closed at the beginning of July. This round only covered engineering costs. Applications have been received and are under reviewed. Awards expected in early September.
- 3. FY26 TEAP Grant
  - a. Calls for projects opened in July and closed at the end of August to provide engineering assistance for traffic safety and operational studies. Applications will be reviewed awarded will be made in September.
