A meeting of the Mo-Kan Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) was held at the Mo-Kan Regional Council office, 224 North 7th Street, St. Joseph, MO. Trevor Tutt called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and took attendance. There was a quorum present.

Approval of Minutes – Minutes from the March, June, and August TAC meetings were presented for approval. Mike O’Donnell moved to approve the minutes as presented. Richard Riddell seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

New Business:

1. LPA Updates
 - a. Madison Woodward reported that the 2026 TAP grants have been awarded. Only Preliminary Engineering (Design) projects were awarded with future Construction awards being contingent upon a new transportation bill.
 - b. Madison Woodward announced that there would not be a call for BRO projects this year, but there will likely be a call in Spring 2026.
2. Recent Project Awards & Upcoming Bid Openings
 - a. Madison Woodward presented the following project awards;
 - i. September

1. Buchanan County: I-29 2.25” mill and asphalt overlay from Pigeon Creek to Platte County Line awarded to Herzog Contracting Corp. for \$6.30 million
- ii. October
 1. Andrew/Buchanan: various locations around the St. Joseph Metro Area replacing overhead truss and bridge mounted highway signs awarded to Collins & Hermann, Inc for \$1.48 million
 2. Clinton County: US 69 2” asphalt resurfacing from Clay County line to 116 awarded to Herzog Contracting Corp for \$4.97 million
 3. DeKalb County: US 36 and Bob F. Griffin Road constructing turn lanes and installing signal poles and lights awarded to Clarkson Construction Company for \$3.02 million
- b. Madison Woodward presented the following upcoming bid openings for November-January;
 - i. November
 1. Buchanan County
 - a. US 169 & Riverside Terrace – realignment of US 169 with relocation of Riverside Terrace Intersection south of existing location, full depth pavement, aggregate shoulders, pavement striping
 - b. Intersection at Route FF – intersection improvements, culvert extension, turn lanes, resurfacing, and pavement striping
 2. Various
 - a. Various locations throughout the district replacing existing guardrail and treatments
 - ii. No bid openings are expected in December or January
3. HPUN & STIP Update
 - a. Trevor Tutt presented the list of projects on the STIP for the Mo-Kan region and the current state of the HPUN list of tiered priorities and Multimodal priorities.
4. SS4A Safety Action Plan Update
 - a. Trevor Tutt presented a list of projects identified across the region by the SS4A planning committee and various meetings held across the region. The TAC discussed projects to be removed or added to the list. Trevor Tutt stated his intention to complete the draft of the plan by the end of the year for board approval in January.
5. County Meeting Scheduling
 - a. Trevor Tutt stated that planning for updates to the STIP and HPUN list should be beginning soon with hopes of voting on priorities at the February TAC meeting. Trevor Tutt requested meeting dates to meet with each county commission. A meeting was set in Andrew County for January 5 at 9:00 am, at DeKalb County at 9:00 am on January 13, and in Clinton County at 11:00 am on January 13. As no members of the Buchanan County commission were present, a meeting will be scheduled with them via email.
6. TAC Membership and Officer Appointment
 - a. Trevor Tutt discussed the need for a new member for Buchanan County and asked for potential replacements for inactive members.

1. Next TAC Meeting: The next meeting is scheduled for February 18th, 2026.
